- Dates and Times:
 - April 25th and 26th: 1:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
 - April 27th: 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Location: Dumpsters and roll-offs will be positioned behind the Public Works building at 276 W. Division Street, Sparta.
- Accepted Items:
 - Rubbish/Trash: Bring household rubbish and trash for disposal.
 - Yard Waste: Dispose of leaves, branches, and grass clippings in the designated container.
 - Tires: Please ensure tires are removed from the rims before dropping them off for disposal. We accept both tires and rims separately.
 - Metals: Recycle your metal items; proceeds will benefit the Village account.
 - Refrigerators: Freon must be removed from refrigerators before drop-off.
- Not Accepted:
 - Hazardous wastes (e.g., paints, oils).
 - Liquids of any kind.
 - Mattresses and box springs with metal.
 - Leaded glass or CRT TVs and monitors.
 - Construction materials.
 - Boats over 12 feet and vehicles
- Additional Information:
 - ID Verification: IDs will be checked at the gate to ensure community security and event integrity.
