- Treasurers Report: Tom
 - September Financial Report: Income from deposits during the month: \$1,792.17. Total expenses during the month: \$24,642.24. Revenue less expenses (MTD): \$(22,850.07). Revenue less expenses (YTD): \$(26,831.63.
 Beginning cash balance(month): \$104,913.01. Ending cash balance: \$80,821.70. Janet made a motion to accept the September Financial Report, Joy seconded it. Motion passed.
- Library Directors Report: Merri Jo
 - Open House: There were 52 in attendance. It went very well. Ideas for next time are to adjust the time, have it maybe 4 pm-7pm. Also have it in September for Library card month.
 - o Advisory meeting report for Oct 9: Sierra will update to 6.4 on Oct 22 from 9 to midnight. Bibliocommons has added some new features. State Aid will stay the same for this year. Mel will also stay the same for now. Book Distribution Company Baker & Taylor will be closing their doors. Many libraries will be ordering from Ingram or Amazon. BiblioCore & BiblioApp will now have customized home screens. They will also have a new on-line order screen to look more like search results with a filter button. Lakeland has chosen 3 companies for ILS possibilities. They will share more at the next meeting.

 - o Village Council Meeting Report for Oct 20: Janet and Dick from Library Board attended. Cityhood: There will be an election for the Charter Commission members to be formed (to write the Charter). Currently the millage for Sparta Village is 12 mills and has been for 14 years. Millages can go down. Village resident Sue Johnson spoke in favor of the library.
