Library Directors Report: Lois

- Changes to 2018-19 budget: increase wages/FICA budget and decrease book budget.
- Phone system quotes: Standard Computers, Control Communications and Classic Telephone all gave quotes. Lois and Debbie recommend that Classic Telephone was the best fit and price for the library. Consensus of the board is to go with Classic Telephone. Lois will contact them.
- Smoke/ Carbon Monoxide Alarms: We will be purchasing 4 smoke and carbon monoxide alarm combos and Dane Poling will be installing them.
- Water Heater and Floor Tile Update: Lois will be talking to the Sparta Township Board on April 12 about it.
- Cameras upstairs: Lois got a phone quote from Mid State Security for \$6000. Jane has a security camera that she will donate to the library.
 Lois will ask Ryan Hayes if he could install it.

- BHS Insurance Renewal: Liability property insurance. This is \$2,262 per year. We will not be getting terrorism insurance at this time. LLC will possibly have insurance for this in the future.

 - Nicole attended the Lions Club meeting and gave them a report on the different youth programs.
